A Reflection for the Feast of Corpus Christi, "The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ". Sunday 2nd June 2024.

With the Easter Season just ended there remains the wonderful invitation and gift from Jesus Christ to each one of us: "Do this in memory of me". In Holy Week we recalled that at the Last Supper Jesus showed his love and care for all people in washing the feet of the apostles. The depth of that love was then shown in his giving to the apostles the Sacrament of his Death and Resurrection, the Eucharist: "Take and eat, take and drink, my body, my blood, given up for you", - the sacrament of 'the Bread of Life', food for life's journey.

In recent weeks in all parishes there has been First Holy Communion Mass. What a wonderful occasion for family, school, and parish. May the children truly come to appreciate Christ presence and love in their lives. May they grow up with a sense of the blessing Sunday Mass is in all our lives.
