The Touch of the Master's Hand

The poem, "The Touch of the Master's Hand," by Brooks Welch; tells the story of the auctioning of an old, dusty violin. The violin was about to be sold for a mere \$3 when a grey-haired man stepped forward, picked it up, dusted it off, tuned it, and began to play. The man played such sweet music that, when he finished, the bidding jumped into the thousands of dollars. What transformed the dusty old violin into a precious instrument? The touch of the Master's hand. — The same "touch of the Master's hand" continues to transform our lives today. By God's touch we become His instruments to accomplish the marvellous works described in today's Psalm 146: "to secure justice for the oppressed, give food to the hungry and set the captives free."

All three scripture readings this Sunday speak of a God Who is partial to the voiceless and the afflicted. Today, however, many of us have lost the ability to recognise the Voice of God calling us for action in our modern society. We are asked to give hearing and voice to the deaf and the mute. The person healed becomes a living witness to the power of God. A Church that is to bear witness to the example of Jesus 'love must not neglect "those who are bowed down." Through her healing presence, the Church must give voice to the voiceless.
